MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- Graders are out around the county! On the list this week are Arlington, Columbia, and Lawrence Townships.
- Intersections in Pine Grove, Almena, Hamilton, and Decatur Townships are being swept this week.
- De-berming continues on CR 388 in South Haven, Geneva, and Columbia Townships. The de-berming crew will then move to CR 687 in Hartford and Keeler Townships.
- Tree crews began a project on Tuesday, May 17th on Red Arrow Highway at Van Kal in Antwerp Township. Tree work will be completed the 17th with the ditching crew continuing the project on May 18th.
- Miscellaneous ditching projects continue across the county as weather allows.

Update

- The culvert replacement on CR 687 just South of I-94 in Hartford Township is complete. The road is back open to all traffic.
- The wooden box culvert rehabilitation on 30th Street North of 62nd Avenue in Antwerp Township is complete. The road is back open to all traffic.
- The project on CR 380 from the Columbia Township Line to CR 665 in Bloomingdale Township will begin Wednesday, May 18th with trenching the road. The road will be closed to thru-traffic beginning Tuesday, May 17th. The contracted completion date for the project is July 1st.
- CR 374 from Red Arrow Highway to 45th Street in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships will receive the top course pave on Monday, May 23rd and Tuesday, May 24th.
