### OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat season is upon us! VBCRC crews will begin applying the preventative maintenance treatment to local and primary roads Thursday. For the full list of roads, please visit [vbcrc.org/sealcoat](http://vbcrc.org/sealcoat). Locations will be posted daily on all of our social media channels.
- Roadside mowing continues on both primary and local roads in Hamilton and Bangor Townships – VBCRC staff will be completing the mowing.
- Hot Mix Patching continues for maintenance patching and crews are patching for sealcoat.
- VBCRC crews are inspecting and replacing crosspipes on roads scheduled for sealcoat this year.
- Dust control season has begun! VBCRC crews are prepping gravel roads in Bangor Township as the weather allows.

### ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township began last week. The project consists of crushing and shaping the existing asphalt surface, trenching and widening the road, completing drainage improvements, and repaving the surface. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street is scheduled to begin this month. The project consists of crushing and shaping the existing asphalt surface, trenching and widening the road, completing drainage improvements, and repaving the surface.
