Operations Update

- Red Arrow Highway from the Village of Paw Paw to CR 671 S in Paw Paw Township will be widened, trenched, milled, and paved beginning August 1st. Traffic will be maintained in both directions under the guidance of flaggers.
- Woodview Estates in Almena Township will be milled, have drainage improved, and paved beginning this week.
- Subdivisions on Cedar and Gravel Lakes in Porter Township began receiving the ultra-thin overlay this week. The contractor is on schedule and work is expected to be completed this week.
