Box 156, Lawrence, MI 49064 until 11:00 AM on March 25, 2025, at which time and place the Proposals will be publicly opened and read as follows:

All Proposals of Interest must be in a sealed envelope and plainly marked as to the item bid upon and the name of the bidder. All unmarked Proposals and/or Proposals received after the submitted deadline may be rejected.

Detailed specifications and proposal forms may be obtained at the office of the Road Commission.

The Road Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in the bidding, and to award the contract in any manner deemed to be in the best interest of the Van Buren County Road Commission.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Van Buren County Road Commission Bangor Garage Office Remodel

1. Introduction

The Van Buren County Road Commission (VBCRC) is inviting qualified construction contractors and firms to submit proposals for the purpose of remodeling of the office located at the Bangor Garage facility, 66174 M43, Bangor, MI 49013. The Van Buren County Road Commission intends to begin construction on the office remodel project as soon as reasonably possible after award of contract.

To be considered, contractors and firms must submit a complete response to this Request, including completion of the attached Proposal Form.

2. Proposal Process

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Van Buren County Road Commission at its offices, 325 West James Street, Post Office Box 156, Lawrence, Michigan 49064 up to **11:00 AM on March 25, 2025** at which time and place the Proposals will be publicly opened and read.

Proposals must be submitted on the Proposal Form provided and shall be placed in a sealed envelope plainly marked "Van Buren County Road Commission Bangor Garage, Office Remodel".

NO FAXED OR EMAILED DOCUMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

3. Non-mandatory Pre-bid Building Inspection

A non-mandatory pre-bid building inspection meeting will be held as follows:

9AM on March 11, 2025

While it is not mandatory that bidders attend, it is strongly recommended.

4. Insurance

A. The <u>successful bidder</u> shall provide to the Van Buren County Road Commission proof of insurance as follows:

\$2,000,000 General Liability, each occurrence;

OR

\$1,000,000 General Liability, each occurrence <u>AND</u> \$1,000,000 Umbrella Coverage, each occurrence

In addition, the following language must appear in the "Additional Insured" area of the Insurance Certificate, without any changes or deviations from this specific language:

"The Board of County Commissioners of Van Buren County,
The Board of County Road Commissioners of Van Buren County
(a/k/a the Van Buren County Road Commission)
and their officers and employees for claims arising out of, under,
or by reason of operations covered by the contract, as their interests may appear."

and/or the successful bidder must provide the Additional Insured Endorsement of their current policy and provide a Form CG 20 37 for Additional Insured Completed Operations.

Insurance as set forth herein shall be in effect for a period of not less than the term of the contract, and shall provide evidence that it cannot be canceled without 10 days' advance written notice by certified mail with return receipt requested to the Managing Director of the Board.

- B. The successful bidder shall maintain, during the life of the contract, sufficient insurance to protect against all claims under Workers Compensation, Automobile Liability, and Professional Liability as follows:
 - Workers' Compensation insurance with the Michigan statutory limits for all its employees assigned to perform services pursuant to the contract.
 - Automobile Liability insurance on each vehicle owned, hired and/or nonowned while operating on the public highways during the life of this contract in the <u>minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 Combined Single Limits</u>.
 - Professional Liability insurance in the amount of not less than \$250,000 per occurrence.

The successful bidder shall be responsible for payment of all deductibles contained in any insurance required hereunder.

5. References

All bidders shall supply a list of at least three (3) business/commercial references including contact names and telephone numbers.

6. Michigan Builder's License

All bidders shall supply a copy of proof of the State of Michigan Builder's license.

7. Bid Surety

A Bid Bond or Certified Check must accompany all bid proposals in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the total project bid. The Bid Bond or other security of the successful bidder will be held until the Contract has been successfully awarded.

8. Performance and Payment Bonds

For all bids that exceed \$50,000.00, the successful bidder shall furnish Performance and Payment Bonds in the amount of 25% of the contract amount, in such form and with such sureties licensed to conduct business in the State of Michigan.

9. Completion of Project, Road Commission Work Schedule and Clean Work Area

Work shall be finally complete and ready for owner's acceptance by October 1, 2025, weather/temperature dependant. If Contractor cannot meet this deadline, an expected completion date for the project(s) must be provided as part of the quote.

All Contractor work shall not interrupt the Road Commission's work schedule.

Contractor will inspect the work area, including any adjoining properties, after the daily work shift so as to keep the work/property area clean of any and all debris.

10. Permits, OSHA, and Rules and Regulations

The Contractor is responsible for any permits, permitting processes, and inspections.

Contractor shall perform all work in a safe manner in full legal accordance with OSHA, State, County, and local rules and regulations.

11. Proposal Evaluation

The VBCRC will be selecting a Contractor based upon:

- Contractor's qualifications and capabilities to provide the specified services
- Staff experience/qualifications
- References
- Pricing
- Any other relevant information

The VBCRC reserves the right to request additional information regarding consultant qualifications, and clarification of pricing information. Failure to provide all information requested shall be sufficient reason for the VBCRC to eliminate a consultant from further consideration in the selection process.

The VBCRC reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in the bidding, and to award the contract in any manner deemed to be in the best interest of the VBCRC.

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
