VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE FOR THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 30

OPERATIONS

- · Fog seal is continuing county-wide with operations expected to wrap up next week, assuming good weather and no equipment malfunctions. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Bloomingdale, Columbia, and Arlington Townships with Antwerp Township up next to complete this mowing cycle. Crews will be clearing downed trees and debris from the ROW during the third round of mowing.
- Total patchers will be out this week in Bloomingdale Township on local roads and in Almena Township in subdivisions.
- · Crews are trimming trees on their plow routes as staffing allows.
- A drainage crew is replacing two large pipes - 36"! - on CR 681 in Hamilton Township and on CR 687 in Hartford Township.

ENGINEERING

- · CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township remains closed with guardrail installation beginning October 1st and is expected to finish October 3rd. Pavement markings will follow the installation. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- · CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township is open to traffic with minor restoration work being completed as contracor availability allows.
- Pavement markings are being laid as contractor availability allows.

MISCELLANEOUS
