OPERATIONS

- VBCRC crews are working on snow and ice control as winter weather events require. VBCRC winter weather operations are posted on our Facebook page.

- Tree trimming started in Riverview Subdivision in Geneva Township this week.

- Crews are trimming trees and applying shoulder gravel on their plow routes as weather allows.
