VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE FOR THE WEEK OF JUNE 24

OPERATIONS

- · Sealcoat kicked off on CR 681 North of Bangor this week and was placed on hold for weather. Mother Nature permitting, we will pick up where we left off on Thursday. For the full list of roads, please visit vbcrc.org/sealcoat. Locations will be posted daily on all of our social media channels.
- · VBCRC responded to over 70 tree calls on Tuesday between 7:30 AM and 3:30 PM. More tree and storm clean-ups are expected Wednesday.
- · Roadside mowing continues on both primary and local roads in Keeler and Bloomingdale Townships, with staff moving to Geneva, Almena, Columbia, and Porter Townships beginning Wednesday.
- VBCRC crews are repairing washouts in Covert Township on 30th Avenue near 76th Street Wednesday.
- · Gravel roads are being scraped and prepped for dust control, with contractor applications expected to occur in Paw Paw, Lawrence, Hartford, Arlington, and Geneva Townships this week.

ENGINEERING

- · CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with crushing and shaping the roadbed. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township is expected to begin following the 4th of July holiday. The scope of this project includes trenching and widening the road, crushing and shaping the existing asphalt, drainage improvements, and repaving. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- Traffic counts are being completed on paved roads in Antwerp, Almena, Waverly, Pine Grove, Paw Paw, and Bloomingdale Townships this summer.
