OPERATIONS

- The second round of roadside mowing is complete! The third round continues in Lawrence and Bangor Townships. Mower Operators will be clearing downed trees and debris from the ROW during the third round of mowing to prepare for snow plowing season and to make next year's mowing easier.
- Graders are treating gravel roads in Arlington and Decatur Townships.
 Contract gravel continues in Hamilton Township.
- Crews are patching and trimming trees on their plow routes.
- · Boom mowers are working through Antwerp Township. These mowers will focus on trees and foliage above what our roadside mowers reach.
- · VBCRC will begin dispatching 2 drainage crews each day to tackle the log of pipe replacements and ditches to be cleared. This week crews will work on pipes on 20th Avenue in Bloomingdale Township and on 67th Street in Keeler Township.
