

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 9

OPERATIONS

- Fog seal is working its way around through Blue Star Highway as well as local roads in Covert and South Haven Townships. Geneva Township is scheduled to follow. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The second round of roadside mowing is complete in Decatur and Hamilton Townships. Mowers are currently working in Covert, Keeler, Pine Grove, and Arlington Townships.
- Gravel roads in Bangor, Bloomingdale, and Waverly Townships will receive dust control this week.
- Crosspipe patches were applied in Porter, Decatur, and Covert Townships.
- Larger washouts are being repaired by a gradall crew in Covert, Decatur, and Porter Townships.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township remains closed with guardrail installation, pavement markings, and restoration expected to be completed this month. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township remains closed with shoulders and restoration being completed this week. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- CR 384 between CR 687 and the West Township Line in Geneva Township was milled, paved, and sealcoated last week. Fog seal is expected to be completed as VBCRC staffing allows.
