

# VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

## FOR THE WEEK OF AUGUST 5

### OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat is working its way through the remaining sections as the rain allows. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The second round of mowing continues in Porter, Bloomingdale, Paw Paw, and Hartford Townships this week.
- Crews will be repairing washouts countywide this week.
- VBCRC crews are working through storm clean ups as they are called in.

### MILLAGE FACTS

- The county-wide road millage has allowed the VBCRC to make improvements to over 10 miles of primary roads with over a million dollars allocated to the 18 Townships for Township selected improvements in 2023. These totaled more than \$2.6 million invested in Van Buren County roads in one year!

### ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Paving is scheduled for mid-August. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Paving is scheduled for mid-to-late-August. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- 38th Street between Burgess Road and 72nd Avenue in Dectaur Township received the wedge pave is awaiting sealcoat and shoulders.
- 92nd Avenue between CR 669 and Porter Township in Decatur Township is awaiting sealcoat.
- CR 384 between CR 687 and South Haven Township is scheduled for a mill and fill beginning last-August.
