OPERATIONS

- The third round of roadside mowing continues in Lawrence and Bangor Townships.
- Graders are treating gravel roads countywide with Paw Paw and Hamilton up next.
- · Crews are prepping for winter by patching potholes, trimming trees, and placing shoulder gravel along their plow routes.
- · Boom mowers are working through Antwerp Township. These mowers will focus on trees and foliage above what our roadside mowers reach.
- VBCRC ditching and drainage crews are working through the backlog of projects:
 - Ditching and culvert replacement on 67th Street South of Territorial Road in Keeler Township
 - Correcting drainage on CR 354 in Porter Township
 - Replacing a 55" culvert in Geneva Township on 64th Street
 - Patching crosspipes in Arlington and Columbia Townships.

 Pavement markings are being placed as contractor availability allows. They are expected to wrap up in the coming weeks.
