Van Buren County Road Commission Implements Weight Limit on 52nd Street Bridge Over the South Branch of the Black River, Columbia Township

THE ROAD COMMISSION WANTS YOU TO KNOW . . .

The Van Buren County Road Commission (VBCRC) will be implementing a reduced weight limit on the bridge that carries 52nd Street over the south branch of the Black River (between 24th Avenue and CR380), in Columbia Township. This new weight restriction will limit the weight of any vehicle crossing the bridge to **7 tons (14,000 lbs)**. Please see the attached graphic for weight clarifications. Weight limits will go into effect when the signs are posted on the bridge, which will happen sometime in the next 7 days.

The revised weight limit was put in place after a routine inspection revealed deterioration to the deck piling which supports the bridge deck. Road Commission Highway Engineer, Barry Anttila, stated, "The 46-year-old bridge carries around 145 vehicles over the Black River each day. The 14,000 lb weight limit will not affect most normal passenger vehicles, but heavier vehicles will need to find a new route. We will continue to work towards an interim repair and then will re-evaluate the restriction. Meanwhile, the weight limit will reduce strain on the bridge and ensure safe passage until more significant repairs can occur."

Vehicles heavier than the 14,000 lb weight limit should use the following detour: 24th Avenue West to CR215; North on CR215 to Main Street (CR380) in Village of Breedsville; East on Main Street (CR380) to 52nd Street.
