MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- Sealcoat operations will wrap up this week and be completed for the year.
- Fog seal operations will continue this week on Antwerp primary roads, Almena local roads, and Pine Grove primary roads. Daily updates are posted to our Facebook page: facebook.com/vbcrc. As a reminder to residents, please remember to drive slowly when crossing wet fog seal applications.
- Ditching and crosspipe replacements continue across the county. Road closures for these can be found at VBCRC.org/RoadClosures.
- Regular width mowing is complete in South Haven, Geneva, and Columbia Townships. The contractor will wrap up all regular width mowing in Bloomingdale and Pine Grove Townships.
- Extra width mowing is complete in Paw Paw and Lawrence Townships. The contractor is currently working in Hartford and Hamilton Townships.

ENGINEERING

Update

- Work on Red Arrow Highway from the Village of Paw Paw to CR 671 S in Paw Paw Township began Monday, August 1st. The project continues this week with milling the existing asphalt to prep for repaving.
- Woodview Estates in Almena Township has been milled and moves forward with a base pave scheduled to occur on Wednesday, weather permitting.
- The project on the CR 384 bridge over the Black River between 68th Street and M-43 begins this week with repairs and maintenance under the bridge deck. The expected completion date for the project is October 1st, weather permitting.
- Several jobs have been let for bid and will be opened on August 30th. The bid specifications for these projects can be found at vbcrc.org/BidOpportunities.
