OPERATIONS

 Staff will be evaluating roads throughout the County and mapping out areas that need boom mowing. These maps will be provided to Townships to assist in determining Township contributions towards boom mowing in 2025.

 Cold patching crews have been out daily – addressing reported potholes as well as those areas observed by staff while plowing snow.

• Stumps are scheduled to be ground and removed on Paw Paw Road as time and manpower allows.

• Crews are trimming trees along their plow routes and along guardrails across the county.

• Crews will plow and lay ice control materials as weather conditons require. Winter weather will impact us this week Wednesday and is expected to require plows through the rest of the week.
