Operations Update

- Storm clean-ups are happening on Tuesday around the county, focusing on downed trees in the Southern Townships.

- Dust control has begun for Townships that signed up for SWMI Dust Control. The contractor will be in Columbia Township this week. Great Lakes Chloride began applying the first round of dust control in Geneva, Almena, Hartford, Paw Paw, Hamilton, and Porter Townships and will continue as weather allows.

Update

- The project on CR 380 from the Columbia Township Line to CR 665 in Bloomingdale Township will be crushed and shaped this week, weather permitting. The road will receive a base pave this summer.
- The following roads received paving last week and will be followed up with shoulder gravel this week:
- 27th Street from 44th Avenue to 48th Avenue in Almena Township
- 52nd Avenue from CR 653 to 30th Street in Antwerp Township
- 27th Street from CR 375 to 44th Avenue in Almena Township will be crushed and shaped next week, with paving to follow.
- HMA overlays will be placed on the following roads this week, weather permitting:
- 33rd Street from 45th Avenue to 48th Avenue in Almena Township
- 60th Avenue from CR 657 to the Village of Mattawan Limits in Antwerp Township
- Burgess Road from 38th Street to 82nd Avenue in Decatur Township was paved over the weekend and will receive shoulders this week, weather permitting.
