OPERATIONS

- · Sealcoat is paused for this week. A vacuum truck is working its way around the county to sweep up excess slag from areas with concrete curbs.
- Roadside mowing continues on both primary and local roads in Porter, Almena, and Geneva Townships.
- · VBCRC crews are completing miscellaneous tasks during this short week including facility cleaning and mowing, tree trimming plow routes, and installing equipment on sealcoat trucks.
- Gravel roads are being scraped in Columbia Township.

MISCELLANEOUS

· VBCRC will be CLOSED July 3rd and 4th for the Independence Day holiday. Regular operations will resume Monday, July 8th. For road-relate emergencies such as a downed tree, flooded road, or missing stop sign, please conact dispatch.

ENGINEERING

- · CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with drainage improvements. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township is expected to begin following the 4th of July holiday. The scope of this project includes trenching and widening the road, crushing and shaping the existing asphalt, drainage improvements, and repaving. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- Traffic counts are being completed on paved roads in Antwerp, Almena, Waverly, Pine Grove, Paw Paw, and Bloomingdale Townships this summer.
