

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat season is upon us! For the full list of roads, please visit vbcrc.org/sealcoat. Locations will be posted daily on all of our social media channels.
- VBCRC started the week off with storm clean-ups after the Sunday evening storms that came through the county.
- Roadside mowing continues on both primary and local roads in Keeler, South Haven, Almena, and Paw Paw Townships with Waverly Township up next – VBCRC staff will be completing the mowing.
- VBCRC crews are patching over pipes that were replaced earlier this spring.
- Crews will begin de-berming under guardrails in Geneva Township this week.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with trenching and widening the road and crushing expected to start at the end of the week. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- The three wedge and sealcoat projects (46th Street between 64th Avenue and 72nd Avenue in Paw Paw Township, 72nd Avenue between the Village of Lawton and the Dead-End in Antwerp Township, and 30th Street between Red Arrow Highway and I-94 in Antwerp Township) received the wedge paving and are scheduled to be sealcoated by VBCRC crews.
